Personal Care Aid

- Work alongside patients in their home.
- High School Diploma or GED. 40 hour training with the Department of Medical Assistance Services.
- \$30,900

Medication Aide

- Work in private medical offices and outpatient care centers.
- 40 hours of Direct Care Training and complete 68 hours of education and clinicals.
- \$40,800

Registered Nurse

- Work in hospitals, mental health agencies, birth centers, etc.
- An Associated Degree of Nursing, or Bachelors of Science in Nursing.
- \$87,600

Certified Nurse Aid

- Work alongside nurses in home health facilities, retirement facilities, and hospitals.
- Complete 120 hours of education and clinicals.
- \$35,600

Practical Nurse

- Work alongside nurses and doctors in hospitals, retirement facilities, clinics, etc.
- 400 hours of Direct Care across the lifespan. Pass the NCLEX-PN exam.
- \$52,300

Licensed Nurse Practitioner

- Registered Nurse license with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing, complete an NP-focused graduate master's or doctoral nursing program.
